## **Club Q Night Club LGBTQ+ Murders Confirmed**

Colorado Springs, Colorado – Police officials have confirmed the targeted Hate Crime Murders Massacre of five (5) members of the Colorado Springs LGBTQ+ Community by 22 year old Anderson Lee Aldrich<sup>[1]</sup> with a AR-15 Military Design Semiautomatic High Velocity Caliber Rifle/Weapon at the popular ‘LGBTQ+ Sanctuary’ club at approximately 11:57PM Saturday night November 19, 2022. The shooter also shot (17) seventeen other members of the LGBTQ+ Community during his armed Anti-LGBTQ+ Attack inside the club. The murderer also had a handgun and additional AR-15 style ammunition magazines that were also found at the murder scene.

### Those Murdered In The Anti-LGBTQ+ Hate Crime Massacre Were:

Daniel Davis Aston - a bartender and transgender man at Club Q who had helped create its positive culture

Derrick Rump – a bartender at Club Q who always had a smile, was a good listener, and one who helped others

Ashley Paugh – who had spent the day with a friend in Colorado Springs, decided to have a fun evening at Club Q before she returned home to her husband and 11-year-old daughter in La Junta, Colorado about 100 miles, 35 years old, devoted to her family, loved the outdoors, worked at a non-profit that helped find homes for foster children

Kelly Loving - a 40-year-old transgender woman club patron, loving, always trying to help the next person out instead of thinking of herself, a caring person

Raymond Green Vance – who had never been to Club Q before, was supportive of the LGBTQ+ community but he himself not a member of it, had just received his first paycheck from his new employer the local FedEx Center, and had been saving his money to get his own apartment

The murderer Aldrich, was tackled and held by club patron Richard Fierro who was inside the club with his daughter and her boyfriend celebrating their friend’s birthday, and by club patron and Drag Performer Thomas James until the police arrived on the scene 6 minutes later.

"He (The Hate Crime Attacker) ended up killing my daughter's boyfriend," Richard Fierro told reporters.
